Charity Purpose: We free slaves today. We are part of the global anti-slavery movement with a specific focus on providing awareness of slavery and trafficking issues to the Bailiwick and Island of Guernsey and enabling Guernsey people to be involved in efforts to free slaves. Slavery occurs when individuals are held and work under the total, sometimes violent, control of their slave holder and they cannot walk away. We agree and operate under the Bellagio-Harvard guidelines on the legal and functional definition of slavery. In Northern India, there are whole villages where people are held in hereditary slavery. Our focus is to work with likeminded organisations and individuals to free the enslaved populations, village by village. So far thanks to the people of Guernsey, 165 people have come to Freedom. We provide awareness of global anti-slavery issues and campaigns to a local audience. We aim to ensure that no one in the Bailiwick is living in oppressive situations where their freedom of action is so curtailed that they are living in conditions of slavery by providing awareness, training by engaging with statutory services and providing training and expertise. We are able provide advice to business to remove the products of slavery from their supply chains. We support slavery survivors living in the Bailiwick by linking them to Survivor Alliance, a survivor based organisation run by survivors.
