GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2013 No. 2

The Foundations (Guernsey) (Fees) Regulations, 2013

Made 8th January, 2013
Coming into operation 8th January, 2013
Laid before the States , 2013

THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 51, paragraphs 3(2), 7(6), 7(7) and 10(2) of Schedule 1, and paragraphs 4(2) and 12(2) of Schedule 2 of the Foundations (Guernsey) Law, 2012^a ("the Law"), by section 501 of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Matters in respect of which fees are payable.

- 1. Fees are payable in respect of
 - (a) any application made to the Registrar under the Law, and
 - (b) any function exercised by the Registrar under the Law in respect of any particular person, and

as penalties for non-compliance with the Law, together the "relevant matters".

Amount of fees.

- 2. (1) Subject to paragraph (3) below, the amount of fees payable in respect of the relevant matters are set out in the Schedule hereto.
- (2) For the avoidance of doubt, the Registrar's decision as to which fee is applicable is binding.
- (3) The fees and penalties relating to annual renewals of foundations shall not be applied until an annual renewal process has been commenced by regulations of the Department.

Person by whom, and time by which, fees are payable.

3. The fees shall be payable in full by the applicant at the time of the application, or within 14 days of the date on which the Registrar notifies the applicant of the applicable fee (whichever is the later).

Interpretation.

4. (1) In these regulations –

"Guernsey Registered Charity" means a charity registered as such under the Charities and Non Profit Organisations (Registration) (Guernsey) Law, 2008^c,

"the Law" means the Foundations (Guernsey) Law, 2012,

"the Registrar" means the Registrar of Foundations,

"relevant matters" has the meaning given in regulation 1,

and other words or expressions have the same meaning as in the Law.

- (2) The notes set out in the last column of the Schedule are only for the purposes of general guidance and are without prejudice to any provision of, or liability arising under, the Law or these regulations.
- (3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
- (4) Any reference in these regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, repealed and replaced (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Foundations (Fees) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2013.

Commencement.

6. These Regulations shall come into force on the 8th January, 2013.
