The Limited Liability Partnerships (Registrar) (Fees and Penalties) Regulations, 2014

Coming into operation 13th May, 2014

THE REGISTRAR OF LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIPS, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 8, 30, 67, 95 and 113 of, and Schedule 1 to the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013^a, by section 501 of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008^b, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after having consulted the States Commerce and Employment Department in respect of the exercise of his powers under section 8(3) of the Law, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amount of fees and penalties.

- 1. (1) The fees set out in the Schedule 1 and the penalty set out in Schedule 2 are payable to the Registrar.
 - (2) For the avoidance of doubt, the Registrar's decision as to

which fee or penalty is applicable is binding.

Person by whom, and time by which, fees and penalties are payable.

2. The fees and penalties shall be payable in full by the applicant at the time of the application, or within 14 days of the date on which the Registrar notifies the applicant of the applicable fee (whichever is the later).

Interpretation.

3. (1) In these regulations -

"the Law" means the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey)
Law 2013,

"the Registrar" means the Registrar of LLPs,

and other words or expressions have the same meaning as in the Law.

- (2) The notes set out in column 3 of the Schedules are only for the purposes of general guidance and are without prejudice to any provision of, or liability arising under, the Law or these regulations.
- (3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^{c} applies to the interpretation of these regulations.
- (4) Any reference in these regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.
